

# ELEMENTARY SCHOOL HONOR ROLL

Student in Grade 4 and 5 have the opportunity to be acknowledged for achieving academic excellence. This excellence is measured by a perfect “**A**” for the school year.

## **The criteria for Honor Roll is as follows:**

- Students eligible for the honor roll must attain a minimum of B in all academic subjects, including E or M in the areas of Art, Music, and Physical Education. (Note: A+ and A-/B+ and B- are applicable.)
- Students eligible for the honor roll must attain a grade of 4 or 3 in the Social Development/Conduct and the Work Habits/Efforts areas.
- In Art, Music, and Physical Education, a grade of 4 or 3 must be achieved in Effort and Conduct for a student to make honor roll.

## **The criteria for High Honor Roll is as follows:**

- Students eligible for high honors must attain a minimum of **A** in all academic subjects including E or M in Art, Music, and Physical Education. (Note: A- is acceptable.)
- Students eligible for the high honor roll must attain a grade of 4 or 3 in the Social Development/Conduct and the Work Habits/Efforts areas.
- In Art, Music, and Physical Education, a grade of 4 or 3 must be achieved in Effort and Conduct for a student to make high honor roll.

## **The criteria for Citizenship Honor Roll (proper behavior and effort) is as follows:**

- School citizenship will include the categories of Social Development/Conduct and Work Habits/Efforts.
- A student must receive 3 and 4 in the Conduct and Effort categories of the report card to include Art, Music, and Physical Education.
- To encourage citizenship outside the classroom, paragraph A above will include areas such as the lunchroom, bus, field trips, and extra-curricular activities.
