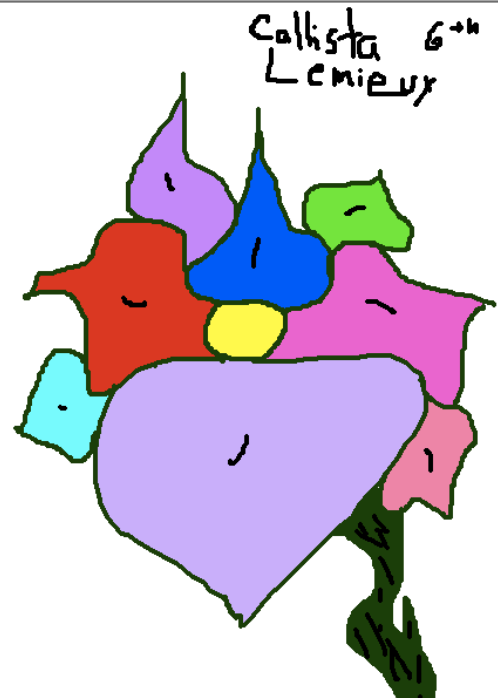

Born on May 3rd, 1469, this guy was a famous philosopher, humanist, and writer based in Florence, Italy during the Renaissance, which was a cultural movement spanned roughly the 14th to the 17th century. He had two sisters, and was the first born son of his Father, Bernardo di Niccolò Machiavelli, and his wife, Bartolomea di Stefano Nelli. Niccolò learned how to speak Italian, rhetoric, and learned grammar. At 29 years old, he was elected head of the second chancery. Later, he was also made the secretary of the Dieci di Libertà e Pace.*
