**2012 WARRANT FOR DELIBERATIVE SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING**

To the inhabitants of the School District in the Town of Derry, New Hampshire, qualified to vote in District affairs:

**First Session of Annual Meeting - Deliberative**

You are hereby notified to meet at the West Running Brook Middle School, 1 West Running Brook Lane, in said District on the fourth of February 2012, 10:00 a.m. This session shall consist of explanation, discussion, and debate of warrant articles number 2-5. The warrant articles may be amended subject to the following limitations: (a) warrant articles whose wording is prescribed by law shall not be amended and (b) warrant articles that are amended shall be placed on the official ballot for a final vote on the main motion, as amended.

**Second Session of Annual Meeting – Voting**

Voting on warrant articles numbers 1 through 5 shall be conducted by official ballot to be held in conjunction with Town voting on the thirteenth day of March 2012. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Districts 1 and 4 vote at the Gilbert H. Hood Middle School and Districts 2 and 3 vote at West Running Brook Middle School.

1. To choose the following School District officers:
  - a) Two School Board Members (each for a 3-year term)
  - b) One School District Moderator (for a 3-year term)
  
2. Shall the School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Seventy-Nine Million, Sixty-Two Thousand, Nine Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars and Thirteen Cents (\$79,062,937.13)? Should this article be defeated, the 2012-2013 operating budget shall be Seventy-Eight Million, Seven Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand, Nine Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and Seventy-Eight Cents, (\$78,736,992.78), which is the same as last year with certain adjustments required by previous action of the School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X, and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. **(Recommended By The Derry School Board)**
  
3. Shall the School District approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Derry School Board and the Derry Education Association that calls for the following increases in salaries including step raises and benefits at current staffing levels:

2012-2013	\$761,986.57
2013-2014	\$848,005.26
2014-2015	\$983,263.30

and further to raise and appropriate the sum of \$761,986.57 for the upcoming fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at the current staffing levels? **(Recommended By The Derry School Board)**

4. Shall the School District, if Article 3 is defeated, authorize the governing body to call one special meeting, at its option, to address Article 3 cost items only? **(Recommended By The Derry School Board)**
  
5. Shall the School District vote to support the formation of a chartered public school to provide alternative high school education to at-risk school students? **(Recommended By The Derry School Board)**
