Dear Parents and Residents of Derry:

The search for a new Superintendent of Schools in Derry is well underway. A very important part of the process is to solicit community input about the attributes, experience, and knowledge that our new superintendent should possess.

In addition, participants will be asked for input on the Long Range Strategic Plan for the Derry School District. This is an opportunity for you to identify immediate tasks that the new superintendent should address as well as the long-term needs of the Derry School District. The information and input received at the focus group sessions will help establish the foundation for the superintendent search as well as the goals for the School District in the years ahead.

Dr. Ken DeBenedictis, a search consultant with New England School Development Council (NESDEC) will meet with interested staff, parents, and community members in focus groups. Each person's contribution is very important to the process.
