WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

Amigurumi with Ms. Silverman **Cost \$85.00 (3-8)** **Sessions II, IV & VIII**

Love Webkins, Pet Shops, or other cute stuffed toys? Come learn to make some of your own! In Japanese “Ami” means stuffed and “Gurumi” means toy. The hottest new trend in Japan and sweeping our nation is Amigurumi. Learn to make some really fun cute creatures of your very own. Basic knowledge of Crochet helpful but not required.

Archery with Mr. White from Art of Archery **Cost \$105.00** **Session IV (2-5), Session V(5-9), Session VI (6-12)**
Fun, excitement and focus are available in this very cool individualized sport. (*Note grade limits.)

Art: Commercial Art in Advertising with Ms. Lipari **Cost \$85.00** **Session II (4-6)**

Advertise a food product as a graphic designer, through painting posters. We can do this with any product line needing to be advertised: fashion, toys, household items, and pet supplies. These are just a few more of the categories with which we can practice. Experience the tricks of the trade how to create great artwork in a short period of time. Become an artistic designer by following simple steps. Have the hands on experience with Ms. Lipari, a former art director/ graphic designer, who now teaches in our schools.

Art: Exploring the Self Portrait with Ms. Palumbo **Cost \$85.00** **Session IV (6-9)**

“You” will be the subject matter for this exciting class. We’ll explore the many ways various artists create self-portraits. Sculpt a self-identity box, design a “who am I” collage; create a realistic contour drawing and cardboard relief sculpture.

Art: Food Glorious Food with Ms. Palumbo **Cost \$85.00** **Session II (6-9)**

If you like food then this is the class for you! We’ll create food sculptures, edible color wheels, and draw or paint many different food items. Artwork by artist Wayne Thiebaud will be discussed and serve as inspiration for our work.

Art: It’s A Jungle Out There with Ms. Palumbo **Cost \$85.00** **Session I (6-9)**

Never been to the jungle? That’s okay! Join us for a week of exploring the jungle through drawing, painting and sculpting. Create pastel paintings, shadow box poster frames, and landscape weavings. We’ll investigate the works of Henri Rousseau and others.

Art: Oodles of Animals with Ms. Palumbo **Cost \$85.00** **Session V (6-9)**

Are you an animal lover? If so, you’ll love this class where we draw, sculpt, and use printmaking to create a variety of animals. We’ll explore some fantasy animals, as well, like the mythical dragon and look at a variety of artwork that features animals as the subject matter.

Art: Paint Like Crazy with Ms. Lipari **Cost \$85.00** **Session I (K-3)**

Express your artistic drive through painting to the beat of music. Paint a birdhouse or a large canvas masterpiece. Experience the style of pop art through spatter paint, finger painting, and printmaking. From shaving cream to bubbles, we paint with those too. It's fun to see and more fun to do.

Art: Printmaking with Ms. McNulty **Cost \$85.00** **Sessions V (4-8)**

Create various types of prints: foam, collographs and linoleum. Learn how to create different types of prints and try some new tools. Create your own stamp!

Art: Simple Bookmaking with Ms. McNulty **Cost \$85.00** **Session V (5-8)** **Session VI (1-4)**

Let's create some fun books to write and draw in this summer! Have you ever made a book from a candy bar wrapper? We will make our own marbled paper for some of our books. Come and explore how creative a book can be!

Art: Step back in time and meet the masters with Ms. McNulty **Cost \$85.00** **Session VII (1-3) & Session VIII (4-8)**

Lessons in art history You will splatter paint like Jackson Pollock, draw "dancing dogs" like Keith Haring, make a wire sculpture like Alexander Calder and create bold, colorful paintings like Vincent Van Gogh. We will learn about other artists and their unique styles as well. This class will use various mediums including: paint, wire and clay.

Bake and Shake: Jr. Kids Chefs Club & Exercise Fun with Ms. Williams **Cost \$85** **Sessions I, II, IV, & V (K-3)**

Learn to cook cool snacks, do fun physical activities both indoors and out, and eat and share the snacks you have created. Is it possible to bake something and play with a parachute all in the same morning? Yes it is! Join us for this class where you can learn to both "shake" and "bake".

Bubble -ology with Ms. Peters **Note: No repeat attendees** **Cost \$85.00** **Sessions II (1-4)**

The world of bubbles...What do we know? What can we do? Is it science? Is it art? Is it math? Or is it just fun?

Cake Decorating: Basic with Ms. DiGirolamo **Cost \$90.00** **Sessions IV & V (3-8)**

We will be learning all the basics from how to properly prepare and frost a cake, to flowers and borders. We will also learn fun ways to decorate cupcakes for any occasion (holiday themes included.)

Cake Decorating: Advanced with Ms. DiGirolamo (**Prerequisite: Basic cake decorating**) **Cost \$90.00** **Session VI(4-9)**

Students will have the opportunity to practice basic skills while learning new ways to pipe borders and create advanced designs. They will also learn to make and use Royal Icing which will be used to make a variety of flowers which will dry hard and can be used immediately or saved for future projects. Students **must** bring their basic cake decorating kits.

Cameo Painting with Mrs. Smith **Cost \$85.00** **Sessions V & VI (4-9)**

Bring your creativity and color sense. Canvas bags and t-shirts , any size– iron on the designs and paint away. This is a new rage across the country. Moms will want to join in!

CSI: Mystery Festival with Ms. Cataldo **Cost \$85.00** **Session V (4-6)** **Note: No repeat attendees**

The Case of the Missing Millionaire: Students will act as crime lab scientists to help solve an imaginary mystery by finding the clues and testing the evidence.

Computer Music Creation - Beginners with Mr. Gantner **Cost \$85.00** **Sessions I & III (3-7)**

Imagine creating your own style of music for the world to discover. Students will learn how to use the program Garage Band to create their own music. (Students in the past have created: video game music, atmospheric music, stories, vocal music, techno, rock, etc.) At the end of the week, students will present their favorite work and will receive a CD with all their music creations. Select pieces may be displayed for download on the internet.

Computer Music Creation - Advanced with Mr. Gantner **Cost \$85.00** **Sessions II & VI (4-8)**

Continue on with your creations. Explore further the possibilities. Find out what can be done once those basic skills have been mastered. **Prerequisite: Basic Computer Music Creation** taken during the summer or explored with Mr. Gantner at South Range. Creative Snacking with Ms. Kitko **Cost \$85.00** **Sessions II, V, & VIII (5-8)**

Try creating and consuming healthy snacks from around the world inspired by fun literature and some new cookbooks.

Digital Photography / iMovie with Mrs. Hoffman **Cost \$85.00** **Sessions VII & VIII (4-8)**

Take pictures with a digital camera, download them into iPhoto and make your own slideshow! Bring in your own photos to use also and learn to scan them. Bring in a music CD and add a song to your show. Bring it all together with iMovie. This workshop will also cover basic photo editing.

Doll-Making & Stuffed Toys with Mrs. Silverman **Cost \$85.00** **Sessions III, V, & VII (2-8)**

The class would include making rag dolls from a pattern, making furniture for the doll as well as clothes. Also how to make paper dolls, puppets and how to make dolls from found objects. We will also explore the making of stuffed toys of all shapes.

Drums with Jay Latulippe from Let's Play Music **Cost \$80.00**

- **Session V (1-3)** Come learn how to play a variety of drums and other percussion instruments. Students will learn simple patterns and rhythms and play along to their favorite kinds of music. Children will be provided with drumsticks. Students in this group will learn how to make homemade percussion instruments.

- **Session IV (4-7)** Older students will learn the same plus hand drums. They will also learn how to play in a group.

Explore Latin America with Ms. Reyes **Cost \$85.00 Session V (1-5)**

It will seem as if you travel to a different country each day of the week. Create and eat authentic foods, participate in hands on activities, learn a new language and join in celebrations.

Flowers, Flowers Everywhere with Mrs. Smith **Cost \$95.00 Sessions II & III (4-9)**

Learn how to make beautiful flower arrangements. Take a new one home every day.

Guitar for Beginners with Jay Latulippe from Let's Play Music **Cost \$75.00 Sessions I & II (4-8)**

Have you ever imagined joining or even starting your own band? Or have you ever imagined being able to sit alone and create your own music? Either way, the guitar may be the place to begin! Join us for introductory classes with this terrific instrument. Let us know if you will not be bringing your own guitar - we can provide one for the class.

Kid's Chef Club : Cooking with Mr. Bell **Cost \$85.00 Sessions III & VI (3-8)**

Become a chef in a week. Learn to create with food from snacks to culinary masterpieces. Enjoy the results!

Knitting and Crochet for Beginners with Ms. Silverman **Cost \$85.00 Sessions I & VI (3-8)**

Crochet is fast and fun! Learn to make wonderful items using colorful yarns. Choose to make a pillow, turtle, pocketbook, fancy scarf, hat, or wristlets. Even begin an afghan! Crochet is a skill you can use for a lifetime. Make cool accessories for yourself. Learn to design, knit and finish a ribbon or balky yarn scarf, wristlets, puppets, a colorful bag, toy snake, or pillow. Knitting is fun! Take it anywhere, and make wonderful gifts for family and friends.

Latin Dance with Ms. Reyes **Cost \$80.00 Sessions IV (1-4) & Session VI (5-8)**

Move to the rhythm. You will learn a variety of Latin dances including Salsa, Merengue, and Bachata.

Lego Mindstorm Robotics with Ms. Tenhagen **Cost \$80.00 Sessions III, V, & VII (5-8)**

This program is the Lego Mindstorm Robotics design course. Students will learn to design, build and program Lego Mindstorm robots. No previous experience is necessary, just a desire to try new things. (*This is a great training program for the Lego Robotics Teams found at both Middle Schools.)

Musical Theater with Ms. Green **Cost \$75.00 Session VII (3-5) & Session VIII (5-8)**

This summer camp is an introduction to musical theater. We will talk about terms used in musical theater and we will do some acting and singing! All participants will be singing and acting in one chorus piece, and solos, duets and small groups will be selected based on each student and their comfort level. A short performance will be given at the end of the week.

Mythology with Ms. DiPirro **Cost \$75.00 Session I (6-8)**

A week long crash course into the Greek myths. Enter this fascinating world, bring along your imagination, and be inspired.

Summer Science Workshop **Cost \$90.00 Sessions VII & VIII (3-7)**

Learn about motion, electromagnetism, light and sound while performing fun activities. Attendees will also learn how to build a working sundial. This session will be a fun way to gain knowledge about the world around you.

Weaving with Ms. McNulty **Cost \$80.00 Session I (5-8) Session II (1-4)**

Students will make various types of weaving projects. Learn about how to create colorful weavings! We will create several projects during this class.

Where There's a Will, There's an A with Mrs. Lagerberg **Cost \$80.00 Session I (4-5) Session II (6-8)**

Learn how to study smarter, not harder, and get better results! Discover the keys to organization, test preparation, note taking, giving a speech, writing reports and papers, improving math and reading skills, and developing your memory. Grade 6-8 session includes information for the SAT test.

Word Power and Strategy Games with Ms. Kitko **Cost \$75.00 Sessions I, III, IV, VI, & VII (5-8)**
